VILLAGEFEST SUMMER HOURS BEGIN THURSDAY, JUNE 2

VillageFest, the City’s popular weekly street fair that runs every Thursday along Palm Canyon Drive between Baristo and Amado roads, will open an hour later beginning Thursday, June 2. The new hours of operation will be **7 – 10 p.m.**

ROAD CLOSURES

CLOSURE OF PALM HILLS DRIVE FOR INSTALLATION OF LINE 41 STORM DRAIN ALONG SOUTHERN SIDE OF E PALM CANYON DRIVE (HIGHWAY 111).

JUNE 2 - JULY 30, 2022 ~ 24 Hours / 7 Days a Week

RIVERSIDE COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL & WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT is installing a 108-inch diameter Reinforced Concrete Pipe (RCP) to carry storm drain water from Cherokee Drive to join the existing storm inlet at Lawrence Crossley Road.

A **24 Hour/7 Days a Week CLOSURE OF PALM HILLS DRIVE** will be necessary for crews to demo and remove existing roadway, concrete culvert, and headwalls under road and replace it with RCP as part of the County Flood Control project Line 41.

Access to businesses near the Palm Hills Drive side of the Rimrock shopping Center will need to be taken from the Gene Autry/Matthew Drive side.

ENGINEERING PROJECTS

2022 SLURRY SEAL PROJECT

Slurry seal will be applied to 60 segments of roadway in Palm Springs, including three major/arterial streets: Indian (Tramview to the railroad bridge), Farrell (Tamarisk to Vista Chino) and Dinah Shore (Gene Autry to Crossley).

Slurry seal provides a layer of protection and extends the life of the roadway. In this process, cracks are filled with a sealant, a grinder lightly scratches the surface and an even coat of slurry asphalt is applied.
